Plants must be sited in a place suitable for their wellbeing. They must not be moved from the position nominated by the Bristol Rainforest. Our word will be final on deciding the best site for the plant

The plants must be kept watered by pouring water in the reservoir tray and not the soil in the pot please refer to tree care at www.thebristolrainforest.org/tree-care

No part of the plant should be cut or cuttings taken

No part of the plant should be ingested

You must inform us of your strategy for tree care over holidays or other periods when the school is not running.
